Jamestown, N.Y. – Four local organizations and an individual have been awarded grants from the Projects Pool Grants Program of the United Arts Appeal of Chautauqua County (UAA).

In addition to providing operating support for six of the county's larger arts organizations, the UAA makes these annual awards for artistic projects. To apply, organizations must have nonprofit status; individuals must have been Chautauqua County residents for at least one year and can work in any artistic discipline.

After being screened for eligibility and fulfillment of requirements, applications are reviewed by an advisory panel composed of artists and community leaders. Their recommendations are then reviewed for approval by the United Arts Appeal board.

Because COVID-19 prevented some award winners in 2020 from being able to accomplish their projects, this year's application had a question specifically addressing that issue.

United Arts Appeal member organizations are the Chautauqua Regional Youth Ballet, Community Music Project, 1891 Fredonia Opera House Performing Arts Center, Infinity Visual and Performing Arts, Lucille Ball Little Theatre of Jamestown, and Western New York Chamber Orchestra.
